The Centennial Theatre offers artists the opportunity to exhibit two-dimensional artwork in the lobby. Because of height and vision access, we suggest that only larger pieces are appropriate. The minimum fee is a \$250 hanging fee or a 15% sales commission, whichever is greater. (The hanging fee must be paid prior to hanging and will be deducted from any sales commission following the exhibit).

The Centennial Theatre is not open daily to the public; it is open only to ticket holding patrons one hour before a performance and during the intermission. The Centennial Theatre cannot offer an opening reception, however, an “Artist in Attendance” afternoon may be arranged **depending on Theatre availability.**

Exhibitors should prepare an “artist’s profile” or a “bio” and jpeg images of some of the exhibited work for the Centennial Theatre’s Web Site. A brief write up about the exhibit and a link to the artist’s web site may also be included.

It is the artist’s responsibility to ensure all works displayed are suitable for exhibition. All works **must be wired for hanging. Work that is framed behind glass is not suitable for hanging due to weight restrictions and lighting glare.** The Centennial Theatre reserves the right to withhold from the exhibition any work not appropriately prepared for display and/or work found unsuitable for exhibition. **A \$250 hanging fee must be received from the artist along with a detailed list of the work including the size and value of each piece prior to the hanging.** Centennial Theatre will provide a staff member (4 hours maximum) for installation. The artist is not permitted to be present during installation and Centennial Theatre staff retains final decision on the display location and appropriateness of any artwork submitted for exhibition.

The artist must pay the \$250 hanging fee and provide a list of all artwork, including the size and value. For insurance purposes, this must be received before the installation.

All work should be labeled:

Name of Artist
Name of Artwork
Price (if applicable)

At least a 36-point font is suggested. Labels must be computer generated. Labels are the responsibility of the artist and must be ready prior to installation.
